| Alzheimer's Disease | Angioplasty for Coronary Artery disease - of specified severity |
| Aorta Graft Surgery | Brain Abscess drained via craniotomy |
| Aplastic Anaemia | Carcinoma in Situ - Oesophagus, treated by specific surgery |
| Bacterial Meningitis | Carotid Artery Stenosis - treated by endarterectomy or angioplasty |
| Balloon Valvuloplasty | Cerebral Aneurysm - with surgical repair |
| Benign Brain Tumour | Cerebral Ateriovenous Malformation - treated by craniotomy or endovascular repair |
| Benign Spinal Cord Tumour | Crohn's Disease - treated with surgical intestinal resection |
| Blindness | Ductal Carcinoma in Situ - Breast, treated by surgery |
| Cancer | Early Stage Urinary Bladder Cancer - of specified advancement |
| Cardiac Arrest - with insertion of a defibrillator | Early Stage Prostate Cancer with Gleason score between 2 and 6 - and with specific treatment |
| Cardiomyopathy | Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillator for primary prevention of sudden cardiac death |
| Chronic Lung Disease | Peripheral Vascular Disease - treated by angioplasty |
| Coma | Pituitary Tumour - resulting in permanent symptoms or surgery |
| Coronary Artery By-pass Graft | Serious Accident Cover - resulting in at least 28 consecutive days in hospital |
| Creutzfeld-Jacob Disease | Significant Visual Impairment - permanent and irreversible |
| Crohn's Disease - of specified severity | Single Lobectomy - the removal of a complete lobe of a lung |
| Deafness | Surgical Removal of One Eye |
| Dementia | Syringomyelia or Syringobulbia - treated by surgery |
| Devic's Disease | Third Degree Burns covering at least 5% of the body's surface area |
| Encephalitis | Ulcerative Colitis - treated with total colectomy |

| HIV Infection - from a blood transfusion, physical assault or at work | |
